


1) Evaluation of current practices of religious slaughter

The aim of the study was to assess some procedures of the current methods of Halal slaughter. This report contains information on the procedures of current Halal practices in EU countries (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain and the UK), Turkey and Australia were collected through spot visits in 18 cattle, 12 sheep, and 5 poultry abattoirs. The spot visit consisted on the assessment of the handling and restraint methods, stunning, neck cutting procedures and post-cut management in each abattoir.

Information on current religious slaughter practices in EU countries (France, Germany, Italy, Spain, the UK, the Netherlands and Belgium), a candidate country (Turkey) and associate countries (Israel and Australia) was collected through 2 types of questionnaires during 2007 and 2008. The first questionnaire aimed to collect data from the competent authorities about the number of animals slaughtered for Halal and Kosher. The second questionnaire was used to collect information on the restraining methods, pre-slaughter and post-cut stunning practices.
